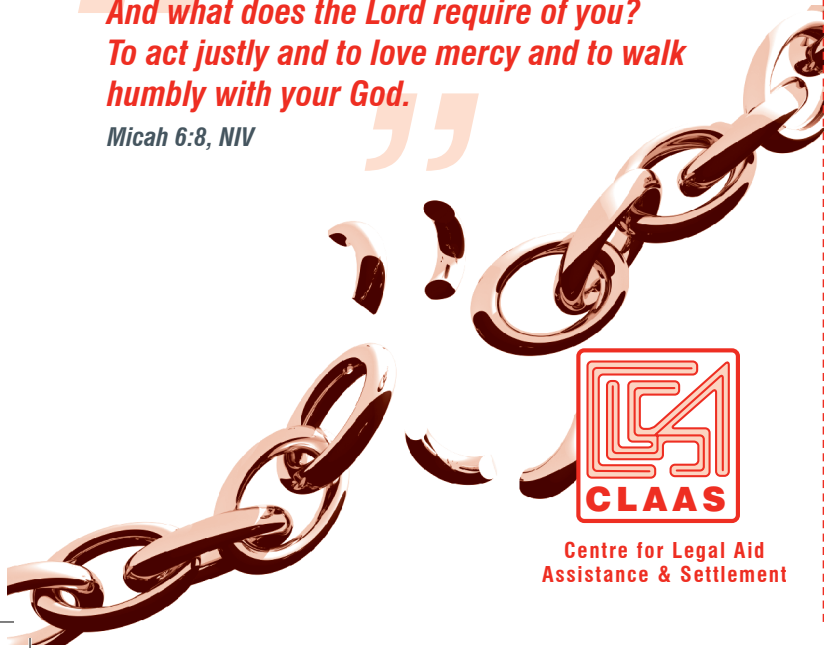

Dear High Commissioner,
